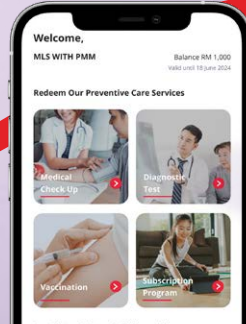

Ready to start your health screening? Here's how:



GENERAL



- Blood test,
- Urine test,
- Lipid profile,
- Liver/renal function tests, &
- Cancer tumour marker.

FOR MEN



- Additional focus on heart (stress test) &
- Ultrasound for prostate function check.

FOR WOMEN



- Pap smear &
- Ultrasound/mammogram for breast check.

FOR KIDS



- Vision examination,
- Early childhood assessment,
- Full blood profile test (Doctors can find possible problems like anaemia, infections or other conditions for your children).

FOR ALL AGES



- Hearing assessment – Audiologists will examine your ear, conduct hearing tests, (audiometry and tympanometry) and evaluate your ability to hear sounds and the functionality of your inner ear.
- Allergy test – This includes tests that identify the source of your allergies including food, air, and skin sensitivities.
- Eye screening – Ophthalmologists will examine your eyes, perform visual tests, and assess various factors such as eye muscle function, dry eye symptoms, visual acuity, eye fluid pressure, and glaucoma risk to identify any vision problems and eye disorders.

FOR CHILDREN



- Early childhood assessment where professionals will look into the emotional, social, and cognitive development of your child.

FOR MOTHERS



- Prenatal screening like Non-Invasive Pregnancy Test (NIPT).
